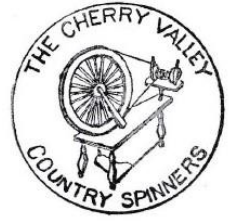

Holiday Potluck Luncheon

Note the meeting location and time change: The meeting will be held at the home of Judy Larter, we'll start at 11:00am. Bring a dish to pass for the Holiday Potluck Luncheon along with your own place setting. Due to parking limitations, please arrange to carpool with fellow guild members. Park on the grass along the driveway or if snowy Judy will have a plowed area.

Directions to Judy's home from Manlius or Fayetteville:

From Rt 173 take a right onto S Eagle Village Rd for a mile, then a left on Peck Hill Rd for 1.5 miles. W Lake Rd will be on your right, go about a mile and Judy's long dirt driveway is on the left with a granite post and weathervane.

From Cazenovia:

Head north on Forman St / E Lake Rd for 3.7 miles. Turn left onto N Lake Rd, after .8 miles, turn right onto W Lake Rd. After .7 miles you will reach Judy's long dirt driveway with a granite post and weathervane.

For a bit of fun for those interested, we'll hold a **Secret Elf Grab Bag**. The gift should be a small token of friendship, less than ten dollars. It doesn't have to be fiber related; it can be something handmade or anything you'd like to give (a small tin of cookies, a jar of jam, an ornament, etc).
