

### **Make a Kumihimo Braid**

Kumihimo is a Japanese technique used to make braids or cords. Supplies are simple: a Kumihimo disc and some kind of cord or smooth yarn. If you already own a Kumihimo disc, or yarn/cord you'd like to try, please bring them. We'll have extra discs and yarn for braids at the meeting. You can also buy discs at Joann's in the beading section or online. Contact Judy Larter or Joyce Lock if you have questions.
